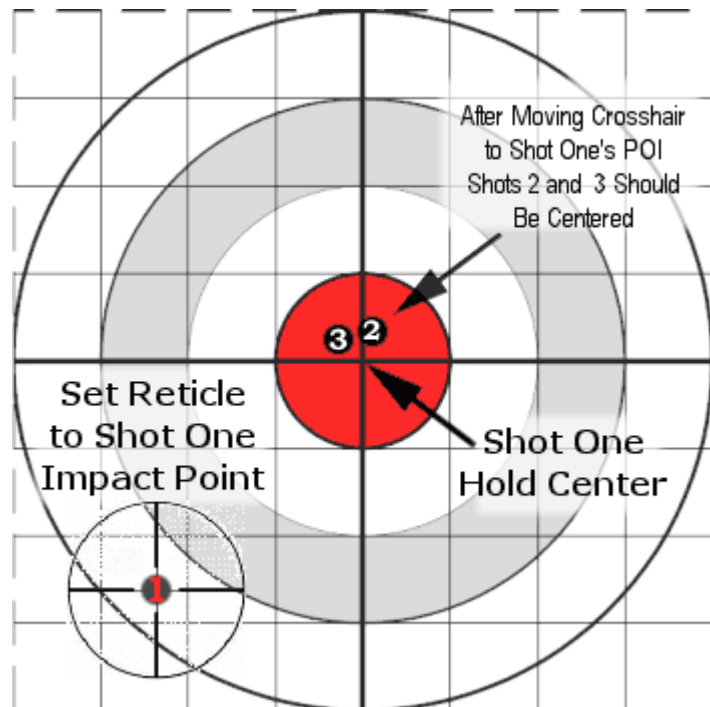

Minutes for October 1st, 2018

1. The meeting was called to order with a declaration of a quorum and the Pledge of Allegiance by President Tim Matthews.
2. Secretary Andrew Malcolm read the minutes from the last meeting which were approved.
3. Vice President Levi Abbott introduced Mike Moser (candidate for the Nebraska State Legislature) who spoke to the club for a few minutes. He answered questions from club members concerning gun related topics and other issues.
3. Treasurer Doug Olsen was absent. He did, however, provide a detailed report on the income, expenses, checking and savings balances for the month. The club has a total of \$55,682.14 in checking and savings. There was a question from the floor with regard to moving some of our club money out of our checking account into a CD in order to earn more interest. The Executive Committee will look into this and report back to the club at the November meeting.

4. Range Officer Ron Brooks reported that the gongs at the range have been repaired, the falling plate rack has been returned to the south Target Shed bay, and that the dirt work still has not been done. Koch's Excavating has not completed this work yet. **Ron again reminded club members to not shoot steel plates with high velocity rounds at close range. The gongs are 200 yards away for a reason.**
5. Membership Officer Bevin Baker was not present. Two gentlemen stood and introduced themselves. They both completed and turned in application forms on the spot. Individuals wishing to join the club must be approved by the Executive Committee.
- 6 Old Business
 - a. The Participation Records were reviewed with the club. The exemption for members 65 and older is not automatic, it must be approved by the Executive Committee as per our By-Laws. All members are encouraged to participate in club activities during the calendar year and not wait until the last minute to "get their hours". Someone has to do the work to make sure your "place to shoot" is ready to go when you show up.
7. New Business
 - a. Hunter Sight-In day is scheduled for Oct. 21-2018. Joe Brown is in charge of this event. If you are going to help, please bring a spotting scope along with your hearing and eye protection.



- b. There will be a Work Party on October 20, 2018, which is the day before in order to rebuild and re-face target frames. There is a lot of trash that needs to be hauled away and a general cleanup is sorely needed. If you staple a target to a frame, please remove it before you leave the range and take it with you or at least place it in the trash.

We will also be drilling a lot of holes in the range for target legs to fit into. The old ones have been filling up and the entire row at 50 yards has been lost. The club has

purchased a 3" dirt auger for this purpose. The bottom of the hole will be filled with some gravel and a section of PVC pipe with then be placed in the hole. A small amount of "cure in the ground" concrete mix will then be poured around the PVC to hold it in place. Caps will be placed over the PVC pipes to keep them clean.

8. A motion was made by Leon Jansen to adjourn at 8:01 pm. The motion was seconded by Willy Chestnut. Attendance for this meeting was 24 members and 2 guests.
