Minutes for December 3, 2018

1. The meeting was called to order with a declaration of a quorum and the Pledge of Allegiance by President Tim Matthews.
2. Secretary Andrew Malcolm read the minutes from the last meeting, which were approved.
3. Vice President Levi Abbott talked briefly about the baffle project that the club has been exploring for awhile. He has received some firm quotes on this project. The costs have gone up since we first started talking about this idea. The purpose of erecting a baffle at the range would be to help keep rounds from leaving our range.
3. Treasurer Doug Olsen reported on the income, expenses, checking and savings balances for the month. The club has a total of \$60,582.00 in checking and savings.
4. Range Officer Ron Brooks reported on a new policy concerning "Guest Waivers". The Executive Committee has been advised by our legal counsel, to require all guests at the range to sign a "Guest Waiver" form every time they come to the range. Participants in scheduled events are covered by our insurance, but guest are not covered the same way. Club members asked some good questions on how this policy would be implemented at the range.
 - a. The "Guest Waiver" policy will start January 1, 2019.
 - b. A copy of the waiver form will be placed on the club website so members can print them off before they come out to the range.
 - c. Copies of the Guest Waiver" form will be available at the range at the new information board which will be erected near the entrance to the range.
 - d. A "Guest Waiver" form must be placed in the collection box each and every time a guest visits the range. Failure to do so will constitute Trespassing on the guest's part.
6. Old Business
 - a. The Participation Records were reviewed with the club.
 - b. Koch's will come out and do the dirt work in the spring.
 - c. There are currently 17 people on the waiting list to become club members.
