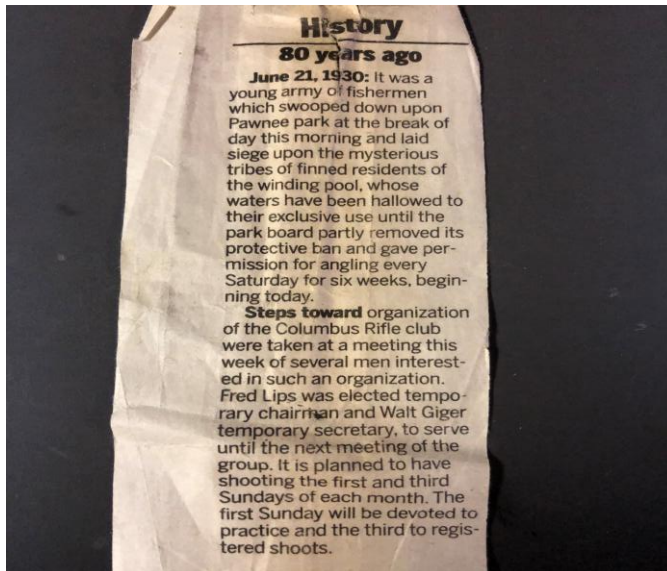




# September 2019 Newsletter
