Minutes for September 2nd, 2019

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Tim Matthews with a declaration of a quorum and the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Secretary Andrew Malcolm read the minutes from the last meeting which were approved.
3. Vice President Jerome Slusarski reviewed the list of members who have signed up to help at the gun show. Members are needed to help with set up on Friday morning and cleanup on Sunday afternoon.

4. Treasurer Doug Olsen provided a detailed report on the income, expenses, checking and savings balances for the month. We have \$24,323.23 in checking and \$1,047.64 in savings. We recently moved the rest of the club's money to CD's to earn a better return on our money.
5. Range Officer Ron Brooks reported on some safety issues at the range. A member chopped down some of the sunflowers, but there is still some left which need to be cut down. Any member can earn some hours taking care of these trouble-makers. Just get ahold of Ron Brooks to work out the details.
6. Membership Officer, Dave Lawrence reported that there are 4 people on the waiting list and that participation hours will be updated in October.
7. Old Business -
 - a. A short discussion on the law enforcement groups using our range for training and qualification purposes. No clear decision was made on this topic.
 - b. The subject of minimum match charge was brought up. Currently the minimum charge for shooting in a match is \$5.00, with the general rule being, if you shoot you pay. The suggestion has been made for 2020, the minimum charge be increased to \$10.00.
8. New Business
 - a. There was a short discussion about increasing the club dues for 2020. Following the discussion, Leon Jansen made a motion to raise the dues to \$125.00 for 2020. Fred Brooks seconded the motion which passed.
 - b. **Bill Suiter brought up the idea of having a club get together again this year. It was discussed and ideas popped up like weeds. In the end it was decided that the club would hold a Pot-Luck dinner at the range on October 6th, 2019. The dinner will be held under the covered firing line starting at 6:00 pm. Tables will be provided, but attendees should bring their own chairs. Ron Brooks is in charge of maintaining a list on our website of what dishes everyone has signed up to bring. There will be a number of shooting activities starting at 4:00 pm in conjunction with this event. A Bowling Pin shoot, "Know Your Limits", Steel Challenge and USPSA type activities are all being discussed. Stay tuned to your email or the club website for the latest information.**
